Notre Dame High School

Notre Dame Junior Senior High School was founded in 1951 as the first Catholic secondary school in the Genesee region. Today, Notre Dame is a Catholic high school of 229 students, grades 7 – 12. 50% of professional staff has a Master's Degree. Students from Batavia and surrounding communities in Genesee, Orleans, Erie, Livingston, Monroe and Wyoming counties comprise a student body that is 60% Catholic.

Community

Surrounded by rural communities, Batavia is a small city in Genesee County, in the Finger Lakes Region of Western New York State. It is also home to Genesee Community College, giving Notre Dame's students the opportunity to take college level dual enrollment courses while in high school as well as to attend college while living at home.

All students are encouraged to take SAT and/or ACT exams. All juniors and sophomores take the PSAT.

Curriculum

In addition to NYS requirements for graduation, all students take Religious Studies, thus earning a Diocesan Diploma. Regents and dual enrollment college credit courses are offered. Students complete coursework over and above the NYS Regents Diploma requirements. A sequence is offered in Religious Studies as well as the standard New York State public school offerings. Notre Dame Students also have the opportunity to explore various careers by attending the Health Careers Academy or the Justice Careers Academy through Genesee Community College (GCC). Vocational courses are available at the Genesee Valley Educational Partnership located in Batavia. Customized internship's and work study programs are also available.

**Comprehensive Senior Assessment Requirement:**

All seniors must demonstrate mastery in each of the following areas: writing, speaking, reading, researching, creative thinking, problem solving, working as part of a team, and computer skills. The Assessment requires individual presentations, as well as group problem solving presentations to a panel of independent judges.

**Community Service Requirement:**

All students are expected to complete 4 years of community service as part of their Religious Studies course requirements. A minimum of 57 service hours is required.
