Kathryn Redick Thompson '03

Kathryn Redick was a key member of 4 Lady Irish sports programs at ND from 2000-2003 and a 2 time recipient of the ND "Female Athlete-of-the-Year" [2001, 2002]!

She was a member of 3 Genesee Region [GR] Varsity Volleyball Championship teams [2000, 2001,2002], 2 NYSPHSAA Section V Class D Championship teams [2001-2002] and one NYSPHSAA "Final 4" team [2002] during her star-studded volleyball career playing for ND Hall of Fame Coach Rhonda DiCasolo [HOF '17].

As a sophomore, she was named "Rookie of the Year" on ND's Genesee Region championship volleyball team [2000]. As a junior, she received recognition as a GR League All-Star, the Section V Class D MVP and All-Tournament Team selection and a 3rd Team All-State NYSPHSAA all star. During her senior volleyball season [2002], Kathryn captained her team, was named a Genesee Region [GR] All-Star and received prestigious recognition as a 1st team All-State team selection. She was also named to the Barker and Canandaigua All-Tournament All-Star teams. Her junior and senior varsity volleyball teams compiled an overall record of 44 - 2!

On the hardcourt playing for ND Hall of Fame ['02] Coach Bill Wade, Kathryn was a key member of 3 Section V NYSPHSAA Class D Championship teams [2001, 2002 and 2003], a Far Western Regional Championship Champion [2002] and a NYSPHSAA Class D State Finalist [2002] squad.

A 3 time varsity letter recipient, Kathryn was named to the Section V Class D All-Tournament team twice [2001, 2002] as well as to the Batavia Rotary All Tournament team [2002].

As a Softball team member, Kathryn was her JV team Captain and MVP as a sophomore and a Section V 2nd team All-State and Genesee Region [GR] Honorable Mention All Star as a junior.

She competed as a member of the ND Track and Field team as a senior earning a varsity letter. Outside of her sports accomplishments, Kathryn was an anima Christi inductee in 2002, in Mission Club and Student Senate'02 and '03, and won the NYS attorney general triple c award in 2002.

After her graduation from ND in 2003, she earned an Associate Degree in Applied Science [AAS] from Genesee Community College as well as a degree in stenography from Alfred State University in 2008. Kathryn and her husband Brian Thompson and their 4 children - PennyJo [12], Shirley [10], Lillian [9] and Junior [7] reside in Alexander, New York where Kathryn enjoys her role of being a full time Mom as well as being a volunteer basketball coach for 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th grade basketball in Alexander with Tritown Youth Athletics and also a softball coach volunteer with Tritown.
