Mike Redick '97

Mike Redick was a key member of Fighting Irish Football, Basketball and Baseball teams from 1993 - 1997.

A 3 year Varsity letter winner in Football, Mike received the Most Outstanding Defensive Back twice [1995, 1996] and was named a Genesee Region [GR] All-Star as a wide receiver free safety and kicker during his senior year. He also received Honorable Mention All Greater Rochester [AGR] recognition, NYSPHSAA Class D 2nd Team Wide Receiver recognition and was named to the annual summer Eddie Meath All- Star game during his senior football season.

Mike was a member of 3 Genesee Region [GR] basketball championship teams [1995-1997], 2 Section V Boys Basketball championship squads [1995, 1997] and one runner up Finalist [1996] coached by legendary ND Boys Basketball coach Mike Rapone '71 [HOF '96] as well as the 1997 NYSPHSAA Far Western team championship team which advanced to the NYSPHSAA "Final 4" in Glens Falls, New York.

Additional recognition earned during his Fighting Irish Boys Basketball career included being a member of ND's 1st undefeated regular season in school history [1996-97], twice being named to the Section V Class DD All-Tournament team [1996, 1997] as well as being recognized as the MVP of both the Medina Christmas Tournament and the Batavia Lions Club during his season season.

The 1997 ND Boys Basketball MVP, Mike also received additional recognition as a 2nd Team All Greater Rochester [AGR] selection, a NYSPHSAA 1st Team All-State team member and a Section V Ronald McDonald All Star Game participant during his senior year. He finished his amazing hoop career tied for 10th on the ND Boys Basketball all-time scoring list.

On the diamond, Mike received the Coach's Award [1995] and was an outfielder on the ND Boys Baseball NYSPHSAA Section V Championship teams [1996 - Class D and 1997 - Class DD] and the 1997 NYSPHSAA Far Western Regional Finalist squad.

He was named the 1997 "Male Athlete of the Year" along with classmates and teammates Otis Thomas and Vinny Fanara.

A National Honor Society member, Mike graduated 7th in his class and was a recipient of the prestigious Anima Christi Award for exemplary service to others as well as the Kiwanis Club Award of Batavia and D.A.R. Good Citizen Award for Genesee County.

He attended Nazareth College of Rochester and graduated with a B.A. in Economics in 2001. During his college career, he was a 4 year letter winner and 2 time Captain [2000, 2001] of the Nazareth Golden Flyers Mens collegiate basketball program and graduated as a member of Nazareth Men's Basketball top 10 for career games played. He also received the Nazareth College Bill Carey Sportsmanship Award and the ND Sports Boosters Amateur Athlete of the Year Award during his senior collegiate season [2001].

Mike and his wife Nancy and their 2 children - Jenna [11] and Andrew [5] currently reside in Byron, New York. He currently serves as the Accounting Manager at St. Pius X Church Federal Credit Union in Chili, New York.
